Unlike welded steel, which is only "as good as the welder," Harris says, these bolt-up structures are fabricated using only the finest materials. They also have the advantage of being expanded easily, so the structures can continually meet the growth and changing needs of any business.

"Our buildings are sturdy, affordable, portable and faster to assemble," he explains. "If you decide to add an awning, we can do that. If you have an existing 8,000-square-foot bolt-up building and you want to expand another 8,000 square feet, we can do that, as well."

"If you move and you don't want to sell the building along with the property, it can be disassembled and moved to your new location. Just simply pour another concrete slab and reassemble it where you want it."

All of the site preparation required to erect a steel structure — clearing of the site, excavation, building up the dirt pad, forming and pouring of the concrete foundation — is handled by Bulldog. And there's no need to try to find finish contractors with this turnkey construction company. Electrical, phone and data cabling, plumbing, drywall and all other essentials for making the new building functional
